

Highlights for The Open Group (2Q, 2006)

I would like to give you a capsule overview of the top ten highlights this quarter from The Open Group:

1. The Open Group welcomed 23 new members in 2Q 2006, mainly due to Architecture Forum, Jericho Forum, RT & E Systems Forum, as well as the DirectNet Task Force. Among these is Unisys who joined as Silver members – a specific target for The Open Group Japan 2006 strategy
2. There are now more than 1,000 Master IT Architects certified under the ITAC program, and more than 1,200 individuals certified under the TOGAF certification program. We anticipate at least 200 ITAC certified professionals in Japan in the next quarter
3. The total number of downloads of TOGAF 8 now exceeds 15,000. This supports feedback at the Gartner Enterprise Architecture conference, which drew a large percentage of the audience, the vast majority of whose organizations had downloaded TOGAF
4. A new group – the DirecNet Task Force - is formed under the auspices of The Open Group with 9 Founder Members (6 this quarter)
5. The MILS (Multiple Independent Levels of Security) Demo, coordinated by 4 vendor companies at The Open Group April 2006 conference attracted more than 220 attendees
6. Category C Liaison status with ISO SC27 formally awarded to The Open Group Identity Management Forum, for the development of a Framework for Identity Management
7. The Open Group is increasingly being seen as a successful conference partner – just in 2Q organizations in France, India , UK and Germany have asked to partner with The Open Group for APC events in these regions
8. PSE52:2003 Embedded Realtime Certification program launched, as part of the POSIX: Certified by IEEE and The Open Group program, and the S/MIME Secure Messaging certification program is now open for business
9. The Open Group was awarded Contract to develop and operate certification program for the NSI Technical Standard: XML Retail Accounting Reports in the Lottery Industry
10. Two of the three initial work items completed by the SOA Working Group: (Definition of SOA, Analysis of Value That The Open Group Can Add to SOA). Proposals being developed for another 6 new work items

Key Achievements for Quarter

1.1 Information Flow & Interoperability

Membership:

- The Open Group membership grew by 23 members in Q2, mainly due to Architecture Forum, Jericho Forum, RT & Embedded Systems Forum, as well as DirecNet Task Force
- Unisys joined as Silver members – a specific target for The Open Group Japan 2006 strategy

Architecture Forum:

- Total number of downloads for TOGAF 8 (the original v8 + v8.1) tops 15,000
 - 2003: 3,051 (v8)
 - 2004: 4,261 (v8.1)
 - 2005: 5,259 (v8.1)
 - 2006/1H: 3,324 (v8.1)
- Membership of the Forum continued to set new highs. At the time of writing, there were 111 members of the Architecture Forum, of whom 72 are paying for single-forum membership. (Others are exchange members and Gold/Platinum Members).
- The Forum approved a new operating charter, to better support its size and global reach

Certification:

- First ITAC certified individuals through indirect route. As of July 3 there are now over 1000 Certified Master IT Architects
- Number of TOGAF Certified architects exceeds 1000

Conferences:

- The MILS (Multiple Independent Levels of Security) Demo, coordinated by 4 vendor companies at the Washington DC conference attracted >220 attendees
- The Open Group has been approached to partner with organizations in France (Arismore/CIGREF), India (Infosys), England (AtE) and Germany (Noventum) for APC events in their regions

Messaging Forum:

- Joint work group formed with members of The Calendaring & Scheduling Consortium to develop a response to the Federated Free/Busy Challenge
- New work item proposed to evolve the S/MIME Gateway profile into an open architecture for an outbound e-mail gateway that is capable of supporting multiple trust models and multiple secure messaging technologies
- Launch of S/MIME Secure Messaging certification program

NASPL:

- Implemented and launched the Certification Program for Bar Codes on Instant Lottery Tickets

SOA Working Group:

- Two of the three initial work items completed (Definition of SOA, Analysis of Value That The Open Group Can Add to SOA). Proposals being developed for six new work items (Relation of SOA to Enterprise Architecture and TOGAF, SOA Reference Architecture, SOA Maturity Model, Ontologies for SOA, Business-Driven SOA, SOA Governance Reference Architecture)

Jericho Forum:

- A significant new member is Cisco, who attended a Members Meeting in June '06.
Significant prospects in our membership pipeline include Microsoft and British Telecom

Security Forum:

- Acceptance of publication of The Open Group Framework for Control of Electronic Chattel Paper (G061, Feb 2006) by The Business Lawyer (probably the premier business law journal in the US, reaching some 40,000 readers) – due for their June 2006 issue
