Resolutions and Notes (unanimously agreed, unless otherwise noted):

### **36.01 Liaison with ETSI SCP**

WG8 asked the SC17 Secretariat to establish a liaison with ETSI SCP due to the SCP's standardization activities on interfaces in portable devices linking contactless interfaces (ISO/IEC 14443, ISO/IEC 18092, 21481) with contact card interfaces (ISO/IEC 7816). WG8's members see benefit for both the groups SCP and WG8 by mutually exchanging their relevant documents.

### **36.02 Project Editor for "Multiple PICCs in one single operating field"**

WG8 appointed Mr. David Main (VISA Europe) the Project Editor for the work item "Multiple PICCs in one single operating field".

### **36.03 Resolution of comments on CD 14443-1 (Revision)**

WG8 decided to postpone the resolution of comments on CD 14443-1 to the next meeting of WG8. It is expected that a version of the modified 7810 and 15457-1 will be available from WG1. This version is expected to include extracted text parts of 14443-1.

### **36.04 Working drafts of the Revisions of ISO/IEC 14443-2, 14443-3 and 14443-4**

WG8 has asked for comments on the current texts of Revisions of 14443-2, 14443-3 and 14443-4 to be submitted to the TF2 Convener by no later than end June 2006. TF2 is instructed to take those comments into account and to develop new texts of those Revisions until the next WG8 meeting. It is expected to decide then to launch those texts for CD ballot.

### **36.05 Project Editor for the Revision of ISO/IEC 14443-2**

WG8 appointed Mr. Claus Freytag (Germany) the Project Editor for the revision of ISO/IEC 14443-2.

### **36.06 ISO/IEC 10373-6/FDAM5**

WG8 decided to let the current text of 10373-6/FDAM5, as presented in N 1158, modified by the requested changes from Austria and Germany, as laid down in N 1196, and launch that new text as 2<sup>nd</sup> FCD.

Those modifications, when accepted by the FCD ballot, will make a launch of a Defect Report on 14443-2 necessary. A draft version of the Defect Report will be proposed by Reinhard Meindl by end of April 2006. The agreed version of the Defect Report is expected to be sent to the SC17 Secretariat right after the successful balloting of the FCD vote.

### **36.07 Project Editors for the Revision of ISO/IEC 10373-6**

WG8 appointed Mr. Pascal Roux (France) the Project Editor and Mr. Mickey Cohen (Israel) the Co-Editor for the Revision of ISO/IEC 10373-6.

### **36.08 Clarifications for WG3/TF4**

Renke Bienert and Wolfgang Meindl are asked to provide technical information on the questions raised by WG3/TF4 in N 1192 (Clause 4) for endorsement by WG8 and then to be forwarded to WG3/TF4 by the end of May 2006.

### **36.09 Defect Report for and Revision of ISO/IEC 10373-7**

Austria will provide a Draft Defect Report on ISO/IEC 10373-7 for to be reviewed and endorsed by WG8. The WG8 Secretariat is instructed to forward then the finalized draft of the Defect Report to the SC17 Secretariat for ballot.

Further, the Project Editor of 10373-7 will provide a working draft by the end of June 2006 for review within WG8. WG8 is expected to decide to launch the actual text of the working draft as CD at the next WG8 meeting.

### **36.10 Project Editor for the revision of ISO/IEC 10373-7**

WG8 appointed Mr. Peter Raggam (Austria) the Project Editor for Defect Report and the Revision of ISO/IEC 10373-7

### **36.11 Revision of ISO/IEC 15693-1**

WG8 decided to wait, until 14443-1 will have become technically stable. Then WG8 will consider a working draft of 15693-1, which is expected to have a similar structure of content to 14443-1.

### **36.12 Revision of ISO/IEC 15693-2**

WG8 decided to launch the text of 15693-2, as laid down in N 1203, for the fastest voting process possible and to instruct the WG8 Secretariat to undertake the related administrative actions.

### **36.13 Revision of ISO/IEC 15693-3**

WG8 decided to distribute within WG8 a new text of 15693, based on N 1204 with the integration of the comments laid down in N 1207, for editorial comments and decision for launching the finalized text as CD, expected to be submitted to the WG8 Secretariat by no later than end May 2006. The WG8 Secretariat is instructed to send then the CD text to the SC17 Secretariat for CD ballot.

### **36.14 Checking the status of 14443-2/AM2, 14443-3/AM2 and 14443-4/AM2**

WG8 instructed its Convener to check with the SC17 Secretariat, whether a possible cancellation process of the Amendments 2 of 14443-2, 14443-3, 14443-4 can be stopped, so that countries may still submit relevant contributions to develop those Amendments.

### **36.15 Appreciation to the ISO/IEC Central Secretariat**

WG8 expressed its sincere thanks to Messr. Richard Cook and Franck Perrad from the ISO/IEC Central Secretariat, who spent considerable and valuable time for a successful editorial finalization of the drafts of ISO/IEC 10373-6/AM1 and AM3 for soon be balloted as FDIS.
