**Introductory note:**

This International Standard has been prepared by SC17/WG1 and is being revised under the periodical review process. The main changes from the 1998 edition are modifications to the Amplitude Measurements (clause 5.5) and the addition of Wave Form (clause 5.9). These are routine changes to the standard that take account of two new standards recently published ISO/IEC 7811-6 (high coercivity magnetic stripe) and ISO/IEC 7811-7 (high density high coercivity magnetic stripe).
