GETTING TO BRITISH STANDARDS HOUSE, CHISWICK

By road

Chiswick High Road forms part of the A315 Clockhouse Roundabout to Knightsbridge route. The Chiswick Roundabout, less than a quarter of a mile from BSI, provides links to the A406 North Circular Road, A205 South Circular Road and the Entire motorway network via the M4 (see map).

There are 400 parking spaces available, of which 300 are allocated to staff and 100 to committee members and other visitors. Access to the car park is either through the Chiswick High road automatic barrier during normal working hours or via the Wellesley Road entrance at peak times (see map). The latter entrance does not incorporate an automatic barrier and will be attended by a security guard from 08.00 to 10.30 and from 16.30 to 18.00 on normal working days. It should be noted that there is no right turn off Chiswick High Road from the West.

Car parking spaces must be booked in advance by calling the BSI Helpdesk on +44 20 8996 7777. Please be prepared to give your vehicle make, model and registration number and the event that you are attending or the name of the person that you are visiting. Space for drivers with disabilities are on the middle level of the west car park adjacent to the basement entrance to the building. Please advise the Helpdesk when booking if you need a disabled space.

Parking facilities for cyclists and motor cyclists are provided on the middle level of the west car park.

By underground train

From Heathrow (Zone 6) Journey time approximately 40 minutes

Take the Piccadilly Line (shown in blue on the London Underground map), Eastbound to Hammersmith (Zone 2). The train will be bound for Cockfosters or Arnos Grove. Alight at Gunnersbury

At Hammersmith, change to the District Line (shown in green on the London Underground map), Westbound, to Gunnersbury (Zone 3). The train will be bound for Richmond.

British Standards House is adjacent to the Gunnersbury station.

From stations in central London

Head to Gunnersbury (Zone3) on the District Line (shown in green on the London Underground map). The train will be bound for Richmond. British Standards House is adjacent to the station.

As there is no lift at Gunnersbury station, wheelchair users and people with disabilities coming by underground train should notify the event organisers so that special arrangements can be made.
