

**MINUTES OF THE 30th MEETING OF ISO/IEC JTC1 SC17, WG10, HELD IN ATHENS, GREECE
ON 17 AND 18 JUNE, 2008**

1. WELCOME

Loffie Jordaan (the convenor) opened the meeting and welcomed attendees. The attendees introduced themselves, and gave a short overview of their areas of interest.

Ioannis Alexakis welcomed the attendees on behalf of the Hellenic Ministry of Transport and Communication, the meeting host.

2. ACCEPTANCE OF AGENDA

The agenda (WG10N670) was accepted with the addition of a "New work item" discussion point.

3. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS / ACTION POINT DISCUSSION

The minutes of the Swakopmund WG10 meeting were accepted without change.

The following notes relate to the discussion of the action points above:

- A list of WG10 members' standards participation was compiled during the meeting. This list will become a WG10 standing document.
- Mr Plessis provided an overview of how the various areas of standardization related to identity cards are covered by various standardization groups.
- Upon publication of ISO/IEC 18013-2, the document "A guide to licensing authorities" will be distributed by each WG10 member to his/her own country's driver licence administrator. In addition, the document will be distributed as follows:
 - EU countries: Niel Akass
 - SADEC countries: Gerrit Fischer
 - WP.1 and represented countries: Gerrit Fischer / Niel Akass
 - Asia, Gulf Countries and South America: Patrice Plessis, for countries in which Gemalto has a presence.
- The latest version of the document explaining the compatibility between EAP and EAC has been drafted, but apparently not distributed.
- When the Project Editor submitted documents to the SC17 Secretariat in line with AP 29.14, the Secretariat indicated that the required action is superfluous in light of Japan's approval of Japan's FCD ballot vote.

4. STATUS OF PART 1

ISO/IEC 18013-1 remains in stage 60.60 (International Standard published). Because of known synchronization issues between ISO/IEC 18013-1 and ISO/IEC 18013-2, the meeting walked through ISO/IEC 18013-1 to identify items that may require updating. The result was a resolution by the meeting to handle required updates in two phases (see Paragraph 10). In addition, several instances where ISO/IEC may benefit from updating were identified. However, it was also noted that the current rendition of ISO/IEC 18013-1 is the result of a significant amount of effort by a number of experts, and that changes should not be made without careful thought.

5. ISO/IEC 18013-2

The final edited version of ISO/IEC FDIS 18013-2 was submitted to ISO for publication. Although the WG10 Secretariat has not yet been informed of the Standard's publication, Mr Daum reported that the Standard is already available for purchase in Germany.

6. ISO/IEC 18013-3

ISO/IEC 18013-3 was submitted to ISO for FDIS ballot. ISO has however not yet released the document for balloting. Mr Sakaki will follow up with the SC17 Secretariat to obtain an estimated date of publication.

7. INFORMAL PRESENTATIONS FROM RELATED ACTIVITIES

Mr Neil Akass of the UK reported that the UK may in October reconvene European Union States that have an interest in implementing a driving licence based on an integrated circuit card with contacts or on a proximity integrated circuit card.

Mr Henning Daum made a presentation on BSI-TR 3110, which includes the PACE protocol in Version 2. Version 1 is being fast tracked for voting to become a CEN standard. Version 2 may eventually follow. It has not yet been determined if Version 2 will be submitted to become an ISO standard.

8. NEW WORK ITEMS

Mr Plessis proposed compiling a test method for the EAP application, as a new part of ISO/IEC 18013. All delegates voted in favour.

Mr Fischer discussed the possibility of a new part to ISO/IEC 18013 to standardise the Certificate of Professional Competence required for commercial drivers. He undertook to do more research in this area before making a formal proposal for a new work item.

Mr Plessis of Gemalto further indicated that a meeting in the Marseilles area in May/June 2009 may be possible, pending approval from his employer.
