There is no section (or in ANSI terminology "clause") 8 in this standard," please take the following action:

and a roll-call vote in M1, 2/3rds voting

Substantive change(s) to dpANS after Ballot

Dear Mr. Buettner: We have nearly completed the production work on BSR INCITS 420, Biometric Profile - Interoperability and Data Interchange - Point-of-Sale Biometrics-Based Verification and Identification. While working on Table A.9 in subclause A.5.2, we noticed a possible error in a cross-reference in one of the notes in the table.

The last sentence of Note (2h) reads: "Encryption by the merchant's POS application is required to follow the encryption standard specified in ANSI X9.84 as described in section 8 of this standard." There is no section (or in ANSI terminology "clause") 8 in this standard. However, clause 7 deals with Security and mentions ANSI X9.84. Was clause 7 meant here instead of section 8?

Since this document has already gone through committee and public review, we cannot adjust this cross-reference without your permission. Please e-mail us back and let us know if clause 7 should be cross-referenced in Note (2h).

I should have a final PDF ready for your review by Tuesday of next week. Please respond as soon as possible.
