**Call for Contributions**

Based on an approved motion at the 23 October meeting of M1.4; this call for contributions is for material in the 16<sup>th</sup> Draft of 1575-D -Application Profile for Point-of-Sale Biometric Verification/Identification. In particular, clause 7 which currently reads

“POS use of biometrics shall follow biometric data protection techniques in ANSI/X9 X9.84 or ISO/IEC 15408:1999 to safeguard the biometric data defined herein for confidentiality, integrity and availability, in accordance with local, regional or national policy considerations”

In m1060801 the editor has created the following options:

- (a) Continue to refer to the 1999 version in clause 7 and include it in the list normative documents in clause 3.1.
- (b) Update clause 7 to refer to the three parts of the 2005 revision, and include these three parts in clause 3.1.
- (c) Identify in clause 7 the use of ISO/IEC 15408:2005 and ISO/FDIS 19092:2006

(Financial services -- Biometrics -- Part 1: Security framework) standards for this profile (removing the use of the ANSI/X9 X9.84 standard), and include these other standards in the list of normative standards in clause 3.1.

At the M1.4 meeting October 23, 2006, it was discussed:

a) The ISO/IEC 15408:2005 has replaced the 1999 version. Inclusion of the 1999 version is no longer an option.

b) If inclusion of ISO/IEC 15408:2005 is necessary, M1.4 concluded that a more detailed reference (e.g., Clause xxx, Part 2) should be included.

c) Whether to make a reference to the X9.84 is still appropriate and what version of this standard should be the proper reference.

(d) Whether the CBEFF Framework should be considered to handle the template protection requirement included in clause 7.

This call for contributions is issued to members of M1 on the content of Clause 7 of the 16<sup>th</sup> draft which will be incorporated into the 17<sup>th</sup> draft.
