Cross Match believes that part 6 should be adopted by the US, and that our existing standard (INCITS 379) should be deprecated, as it has not had too much adoption yet, and thus it would represent good timing to adopt the international standard. As part 6 should be adopted, so should part 1.

Part 2 should be adopted, but INCITS 378 should not be deprecated, as it is being referenced by many national projects.

Part 4 should be adopted, and INCTIS 381 should be deprecated, as it has not had too much adoption yet.

Part 5 should be adopted, and INCITS 385 should be deprecated, as there is not enough of a significant difference between the two to warrant maintaining the US standard. Part 5 (amd 1) should also be adopted.

Cross Match also believes that Parts 8 and 9 should be adopted, especially as there is no corresponding US standard.
