Sagem SA response to the M1.1 responses to public review comments on INCITS 377, finger pattern format.

Dear M. Jones, chairman of M1.1

I have received the M1.1 response on technical comment on Finger Pattern (M1/03-0458).

The comment is rejected.

Sagem SA is not satisfied with the response.

Sagem SA estimates that the response doesn't solve the original comment. In this way, proposed changes have not been taken in consideration. No alternative is promoted. The original comment is pointing that the 200 ppi image reduction is not compatible for a Finger Image rebuilding. The original comment is also pointing that many existing systems are using minutiae.

The response provided underlines that interoperability will be probably supported by the Finger image only. How the existing systems using minutiae are taken in consideration? It is assumed that the finger pattern format proposed is supporting interoperability for finger pattern technology. How is it possible with a 200 ppi image?

To progress in this discussion, Sagem SA would like provide technical proposals, more detailed as the previous one. About 8 weeks are needed to finalize a detailed technical solution..
