About the BIAS project:

BIAS defines a framework for deploying and invoking biometrics-based identity assurance capabilities that can be readily accessed using services-based frameworks (e.g. web services). Biometric services include such functionality as create/delete subject, add biometric, verify biometric (1:1 match), identify (1:N match), etc., which are to be remotely invoked. The integration (binding) of these biometric services within the web services framework is the second part of this project.
