Subject: INCITS PL22 votes to Approve the following US National Body Positions for the SC22 N Documents:

5.4 - The US National Body comment is that the Definition of 07.06.22 of "initiate" in document SC 22 N4323, is confusing and suggests it be reworded.

5.5 - The US National Body nominates Nick Stoughton and Rex Jaeschke to represent SC 22 and participate in SWG on Directives Ad Hoc on Annex H of the JTC 1 Directives, SC22 N4326.

5.6 - The US National Body would like to request clarification of the color scheme in the meeting schedule listed at the end of document SC22 N4327.

5.8 - The US National Body is in sympathy with the problem described in SC22 N4329, but is opposed to the solution and strongly urges alternative solutions to be explored.

5.9 - The US National Body requests that the forms should be retained as templates on the JTC1 web site for information only, SC22 N4330.

Statement: These US National Body positions were approved by meeting votes at the April 28, 2008 meeting. However, It was noted after the conclusion of the INCITS/PL22 meeting, that the meeting votes for Agenda Item 5.4, 5.5, 5.6, 5.8 and 5.9 should have been conducted by a roll call vote, therefore, the proposed USNB positions will be sent out for approval by PL22 letter ballot.
