A correction from WK: The scanner he has available is an Epson Expression 1680, 48bits.

Discussion of YN's comments via email:

- Regarding resolution WK suggested that we should use downsampling in reflectance space, then convert back. WK and RR agree that it may make sense to downsample to a lower resolution (in linear space) to save computer memory and storage requirements.
- Clarification of the purpose of color calibration: For Phase I we do not need accurate color. For phase II, we must discuss it and decide at a later point. This should be explained in the paper.
