

W1.1 Text & Line Quality Team 9/17/03 teleconference minutes

Test pattern creation deliverables, proposed and agreed to by Mark Robb and Allan Haley, and discussed at the teleconference:

- We decided the basic Latin typefaces will be Times New Roman and Arial. Available in Regular, Italic and Bold styles. Alan will verify that Agfa has the rights to provide these faces (or select equivalent faces if this is a problem). Alan will verify that Agfa will commit the resources to build the custom fonts. Complete by 10/20/03.
- Mark will select the non Latin characters needed in the custom fonts. The characters will be identified by Unicode value. The typefaces will be ones that Lexmark currently licenses from Agfa. Mark will define how to encode these special characters in the custom fonts. Complete by 10/20/03.
- Agfa to build Pass 1 of the custom fonts. Complete by 12/12/03.
- W1.1 team members to test the Pass 1 fonts with updated testcases. Complete by 1/30/04.
- Update testcases, produce Pass 2 fonts and retest (if necessary). Complete by 2/27/04.

Further discussions at the teleconference:

- We need to test the "Printer Fonts" path for PCL and PS. Mark will send a small test pattern (incorporating upper left corner of the waterfall pattern) for team members to test on their printers (Xerox, HP, Lexmark, etc).
- Ted Bouk will propose other analytical measurements for text, in addition to those previously proposed by John Briggs.
- We will submit a paper on the status of our work, for publication at the EI conference (San Jose, 1/19/04). The due date is 10/27/03.
